

BVB Organises Munshi Memorial Inter School Recitation Competition and Lilawati Munshi Memorial On the spot Painting competition – 2012

To honour the memory of its founder Dr. K.M.Munshi, BVB's Mehta Vidyalaya organized an Inter School Competition (Recitation and Painting) on 27th April, 2012.
