Training on Disaster Management Preparedness: Earthquake and Fire Safety Mock Drill

Following the DOE Directive and Guidelines to the letter, under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's Mehta Vidyalaya carried out Disaster Management Preparedness Training on Earthquake and Fire Safety Mock Drill Training in the school campus on 19th April, 2022 for Classes III to X & XII in groups of three.

The session was taken up by Mr. Sajjan Kumar, Ex- Fire Officer, NDMC on 'Basic Dos and Don'ts in case of an Earthquake and Fire Disaster'. National Accreditation Board for Education and Training (NABET) Final Visit

Mehta Vidyalaya had QCI (NABET) Physical Visit on 16th & 17th March, 2022 to check the smooth implementation of NABET assessment. Dr. S.C. Kaushik was the Lead assessor and Dr. B. Singh was the Co-assessor for the accreditation process.

On day one the assessors went on the rounds for observation with regard to the functioning of labs and interaction with lab in charges, followed by observation of school infrastructure and learning environment. They also met and interacted with complaint handling committee, action research team, feedback committee, SWOT, School Office functioning and Physical Education department. They further looked into the key findings of the internal audit done in the school and discussed about the Accreditation Manual, Mission of the school, Quality objectives and concluded with a brief meeting of the Assessors, the Principal and Accreditation coordinator.

On the second day, the Assessors and the respective process owners of Admissions, Human Resources and Transport department interacted with the parents / stakeholders. A visit to the Administrative department of the school was done and suggestions were given to improve its functioning. Financial Resources; Examination and Assessment; Ethical values, continual improvement; Self-Assessment and Compliance with CBSE requirements were discussed and valuable points were taken and noted by the process owners for future reference. The two days physical visit by QCI (NABET) culminated with a brief discussion by the Assessors with all the process owners and the school administration.



PARENTS' ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

Orientation programme was conducted for the parents of Nursery (29th March, 2022), Class I (25th March, 2022), Class III (30th March, 2022) and Class XI (8th July, 2022). 
