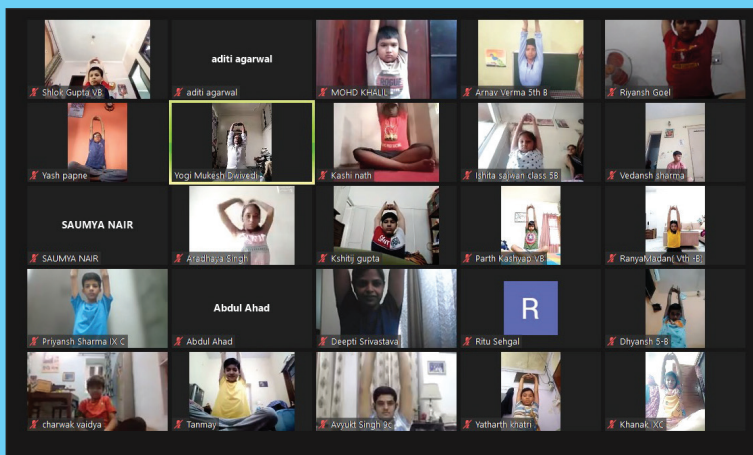


## YOGA UTSAV CELEBRATION

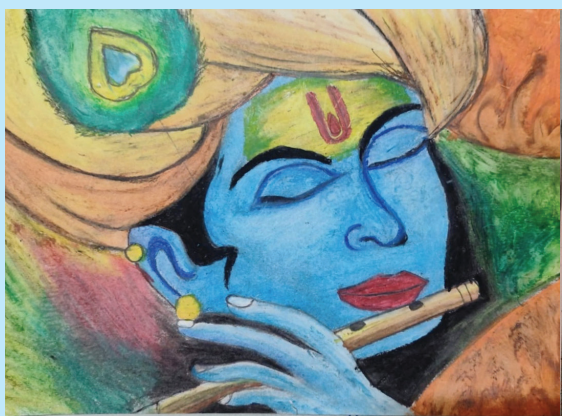
### MAY

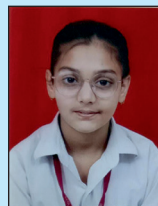

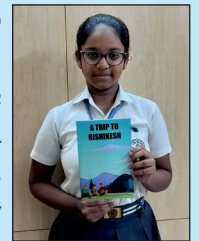
